Employers can purchase this product with or without a primary care physician (PCP) referral required for specialist visits.	Primary Advantage provides in-network care for members within the Oxford Metro Network. This plan offers lower copayments with no deductibles when seeking care from PCPs and OBGYNs, and for Tier 1 prescription drugs. Other in-network provider services are subject to a deductible. Once the deductible is met, future services are covered by a copayment.	The Oxford EPO HSA provides in-network care for members within the Oxford Metro Network and is paired with a Health Savings Account (HSA) for members to use for eligible medical and pharmacy expenses.
